Rubric the awards committee will use for scoring nominations and selecting winners:

	Rating	Comment
Purpose: The nomination clearly describes efforts by the nominee to exemplify diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility in CAFE functions to enhance belonging for internal and/or external audiences. (Maximum 20 points)		
Basis: The nomination clearly defines reasons why the nominated person, deserves recognition. (Maximum 20 points)		
Effort: Actions and activities in support of DEI&A are appropriate, educationally, and organizationally sound, and demonstrate impact. (Maximum 20 points)		
Positive Impact: Have efforts led to positive, sustainable change? Evidence exists that efforts have led to positive, sustainable programmatic and/or organizational change, or there is a clear understanding of anticipated impact. (Maximum 30 points)		
Innovation: The effort is innovative in its application, methods, or approach in such a way that has led to new ways/models for positive organizational change in enhancing DEI&A. (Maximum 10 points)
